

engage in their future 2021 Football Tournament TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Eligibility:

- The 2021 football tournament is open to *engage in their future* member schools and non-member schools.
- Entry is free for *engage in their future* member schools.
- The entry fee for non-member schools is £35.00 per team.
 - Payment must be received at least ten days prior to the qualifying tournament in which the school is participating.
 - o Payment can be made via -
 - Cheque (made payable to engage in their future Ltd and sent to engage in their future, PO Box 451, Horley, Surrey, RH6 6AW), or
 - BACS transfer (sort code 40-15-26 / account number 81369725).

Teams:

- Matches will be seven-a-side.
- Squads should be a maximum of ten: seven players plus a maximum of three substitutes.
- Squads can consist of boys, girls or both.
- Players should be current Year 9, Year 10 or Year 11 students.
- Participation is open to all students at full *engage in the future* member schools with the exception of mainstream schools when all participating students must have a current and valid EHCP.
- Each team will be required to provide a staff member who is willing to support the tournament as a referee at both the qualifying tournament and finals tournament (in the event of qualification).

Playing Equipment:

- All players must wear shin guards.
- Goalkeepers must wear a playing strip that distinguishes them from the outfield players of both teams.
- Correct footwear must be worn for the surface of the pitch.

Misconduct:

- Any player receiving two yellow cards during a tournament may take no further part in subsequent fixtures.
- Any player receiving a red card during a match may take no further part in subsequent fixtures.
- Any cards issued during qualifying tournaments will not be carried over to the finals tournament (in the event of qualification).

Qualifying Tournaments:

- Three qualifying tournaments will be held
 - o Thursday 1st July 2021 The William Henry Smith School, Brighouse, West Yorkshire
 - Closing date for entries is Tuesday 1st June 2021 (limited number of places available).

- Schools are invited to select which qualifying tournament they would prefer to attend then complete and submit the entry form (available at engage in their future.org).
- Should they be required, further details about each qualifying tournament are available from the host school.
- Qualification for the finals tournament will be determined by a number of factors including results, fair play, effort, attitude, and team spirit.

Finals Tournament:

- The finals tournament will take place on Thursday 14th October 2021 at St George's Park, Burton on Trent, Staffordshire.
- The finals will follow a league format
 - o Teams will be randomly split into two leagues.
 - Three points will be allocated for a win, one point for a draw and no points for a defeat.
 - o In the event of level points at this stage, the following will be taken into account -
 - 1. Goal difference.
 - 2. Number of goals scored.
 - 3. Head to head results.
 - 4. Penalty shoot-out.
 - The winning team from each league will go through to the final.
 - o Each match will be approximately 20 minutes each way.
 - Full details will be confirmed on the day.
- In the event of a draw at full time of the final match, extra time will be played (time permitting) or the match will go to a penalty shoot-out (five penalties then sudden death shoot out).
- Schools are responsible for arranging their own transport to/from the event.
- Shenstone Lodge is able to offer overnight camping accommodation if required. Please contact Scott Worton (scott.worton@shenstonelodge.co.uk) for further details.

Medals and Awards:

- Each player will receive a certificate and a medal (a maximum of ten per team).
- A trophy will be presented to the winning team of the finals tournament at St George's Park on Thursday 14th
 October 2021.
- Trophies will also be awarded at the finals tournament for players / teams that demonstrate sportsmanship and embody the spirit of the game.

Data:

- The details submitted on the entry form will be used and shared in the following ways:
 - o Information may be shared and exchanged between the host schools of qualifying tournaments and *engage* in their future. It will not be shared with any other party without prior permission.
 - The data provided may be used and stored by the host schools and engage in their future for the administration of the 2021 Football Tournament. This will include, but is not limited to, correspondence and analysis.
 - The data will be held indefinitely in order to support future marketing and promotion efforts and to facilitate future communications as a result of a schools participation in the football competition.
 - o The data will primarily be held in an electronic format but hard copies may also be used.
